Nursing Per Diem Program

We are excited to introduce a new Per Diem Program that allows for flexible scheduling opportunities for Acute Care Nurses. Over the past several months, we have recognized that a one-size-fits-all model for PRN nurses is not effective at attracting or retaining these valuable team members. Our new program offers a five-tier per diem (PRN) campus-based program that offers flexibility in addressing staffing needs:

Tier 1 is unit-based assignment and standard PRN commitment*

Tier 2 requires 2 years of experience and is a unit-based assignment where a team member may work like-units or competency-based assignments with a minimum 48-hour commitment for a 6-week period*

Tier 3 requires 2 years of experience and is a unit-based assignment where a team member may work like-units or competency-based assignments with a minimum 96-hour commitment for a 6-week period *

Tier 4 is an Internal Resource Pool (IRP) assignment where a team member works like units or competency-based assignments with a minimum 96-hour commitment for a 6-week period in addition to commitment to cover three (3) designated hospitals *

Tier 5 is an Internal Resource Pool (IRP) assignment where a team member works a full-time (minimum 36 hours per week) commitment for a 12-week period with agreement to travel across system hospitals to "like" units or competency-based assignments.
